
cookies and hot cider. Normal pantry hours will be in place, but be advised that Main Street will be closed for this event, so people should plan to park in the back.

Our turkey distribution days are Thursday, November 15 and Tuesday, November 20. On those days, guests may choose to pick up a turkey (and a bag with stuffing, gravy, cranberry sauce and root vegetables) and not shop that day; they may pickup the turkey and fixings and shop at their regular appointment time that day; or not pick up a turkey but shop that day at their regular

appointment time.

- Tuesday, November 20 10AM until NOON


If you can help, please send an email to <u>pantrydirector@opentable.org</u> with your name, #of turkeys & stuffing and the day/time you can drop them off.

#### **Turkey Trot**

Before you sit down to that turkey dinner, why not pre-spend your calories with a quick trot around the block? The Turkey Trot is a 5K run around Concord's MinuteMan Park.

This family friendly event, along with the Acton Turkey Trot the following day, attract over 1,000 runners combined. A portion of both these events benefit Open Table, Acton food Pantry, and area local youth running programs. Come on



out with a super-fun attitude and your running shoes! Costumes are encouraged! Walkers welcome!

The 5K Race, which starts at 8:30 AM sharp, starts and finishes at the Keyes Road parking lot in Concord Center. The top-3 overall will win medals as well as the top-3 in 9 age groups from 12 & Under to 70+.

Participants who pre-register are guaranteed to receive an event T-shirt. Pre-registration is \$30 and is available online or by mail (see the **event website** for details). There is a cap of 1500 entrants, so register early.

Participants are encouraged to bring a non-perishable food item to support the Open Table pantry.
