Here's the schedule for 2019:

- Mondays dinner in Maynard. Doors open at 5:30, dinner served 6-7 pm.
- Tuesdays pantry from 12:45-3 pm for senior citizens; 3-6 pm for all
- **Thursdays** pantry from 3-6 pm for all. Dinner in Concord; doors open 4:45, dinner served at 5:30 pm.
